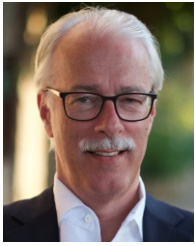

Dr. Axel Hofmann, ME

Axel Hofmann is a Doctor of Medical Science, holds a Master's Degree in Economics, is Visiting Professor at the Institute of Anesthesiology at the University Hospital Zurich, Adjunct Associate Professor at the School of Medicine, University of Western Australia and Adjunct Professor at the Centre for Population Health Research at Curtin University, Western Australia.

He is published in Anaesthesia, Annals of Oncology, Anesthesia & Analgesia, Anesthesiology, British Journal of Anaesthesia, British Medical Journal Open, Current Opinion in Anesthesiology, European Journal of Anaesthesiology, Journal of Thoracic and Cardiovascular Surgery, Journal of Clinical Oncology, The Lancet, The Oncologist, Transfusion, Transfusion and Apheresis Science, Vox Sanguinis and Transfusion Medicine Reviews, and authored/co-authored several book chapters. He presented his work in more than 400 international forums, congresses, universities, medical schools and government institutions.

With his focus on health economics and outcomes research in Patient Blood Management (PBM) as well as in PBM implementation, he is consulting major pharmaceutical corporations, blood services and NGOs.

He is a co-founder of the *International Foundation for Patient Blood Management* where he serves as a board member.
